AGENT ORANGE APPEALS




Oral argument will be heard in all appeals on Monday, June 18, 2007.

Argument in the Veterans Cases (Nos. 05-1509, 05-1693, 05-1694, 05-1695, 05-1696, 05-1698, 05-1700, 05-1737, 05-1760, 05-1771, 05-1810, 05-1813, 05-1817, 05-1820, 05-2450, 05-2451) will be heard at 10 A.M. One hour will be allotted to each side; the appellants may reserve as much of that time as they wish for rebuttal argument. Counsel on each side (if there is more than one) may divide the time among counsel as they see fit.

After an approximately one-hour break, argument in the Vietnam Association Case (No. 05-1953) will then be heard. Forty-five minutes will be allotted to each side; the appellants may reserve as much of that time as they wish for rebuttal argument. Counsel on each side (if there is more than one) may divide the time among counsel as they see fit. The government, which has been given permission to argue as amicus in support of the position of the appellees, will be allotted ten minutes of the appellees' time, or such additional portion of the appellees' time as such counsel may agree upon.
